Preference will be given to candidates with a history of attracting externally funded initiatives pertaining to advising, retention, and/or student success.

- Provide vision and leadership for student advising and retention programs at Lamar University.
- Provide operational oversight for the Center for Academic Success (CAS) and related programs. CAS includes:
  - Student Advising and Retention Services (STARS)
  - Foundations of Excellence
  - o McNair Scholars Program
  - Student Support Services
  - o Academic Enhancement Workshops
  - Supplemental Instruction
- Maintain knowledge of current and best practices in student advising and retention.
- Advocate student retention and advising activities throughout the University.
- Develop, plan, and implement new retention and advising initiatives based upon institutional and student needs.
- Promote understanding and support of the university's advisement and retention initiatives to external constituencies.
- Participate in other related activities as assigned by the Provost.

Beaumont is a community of approximately 120,000 people, located about 30 miles from the Gulf of Mexico, 90 miles from Houston, and 40 miles from the Louisiana border. Lamar University has experienced tremendous growth and expansion over the past five years, with enrollment steadily increasing to nearly 10,500 this fall.
